

Juror, Katie Burke

Kathryn F. "Katie" Burke grew up riding hunter jumper thoroughbreds in Prospect, Kentucky. For 20 years, she and her mother, artist rep Nancy Burke, ran Equine Artists of Kentucky specializing in artwork, custom crystal and trophies for the horseracing industry. With her knowledge of the equine world, she became the retail print buyer for Finish Line Gallery at the Kentucky Derby Museum.

While raising her two daughters, she began studying watercolor with Sue Huttenlocher and Sarah Roush. She has since studied with: John Michael Carter, Louisville, KY; Ellen Eagle at the National Academy of Fine Art, New York, NY; Paul McCormack, Janet Rogers, Carla O'Connor, Steven Quiller, Betsy Dillard Stroud, and Camille Przewodek.

In 2006, Katie began The Figurative Collective, a group of painters devoted to working with the figure directly from life. She also coordinated the Figurative Art and Life Drawing Program at the Mellwood Art Center in Louisville.

Katie and her husband Walter Lay, own Burke-Lay Studio, and are charter members of The Atelier Louisville Gallery & Studios, an artists' co-operative in the Butchertown section of Louisville, KY. She was included in the Smith Barney Salute to 20 Outstanding Kentuckiana Artists. Her work includes figurative art, and plein-air landscape painting in mixed media, transparent watercolor, acrylic and pastel. She teaches these mediums, at The Atelier Louisville Gallery & Studios.

Eligibility

Any artist 18 years of age or older may submit two works. Work may be two- or three-dimensional, no larger than 40" x 40" including frame, completed within the last 2 years, and framed & wired for hanging. Wrapped canvas need not be framed, but must have a finished edge. Neither photographs or nudes will be accepted. Sculpture weight limited to 30 lbs. and 16" height.

All entries must be the original work of the entering artist (no prints). Work copied from another artist or instructor, or from a picture or photograph appearing in print, using its composition or essential art elements, is not considered original.

Entry Fee

A non-refundable fee of \$30.00 must accompany the receipt of application. This fee includes new membership for 2019. There is no fee for pre-paid members of H.S.A. Walk ins will be charged \$10.00 late fee.

Commission

A charge of 20% will be collected by Audubon Museum from the sale of artwork.
